

POINTE COUPEE PUBLIC TRANSIT

Pointe Coupee Public Transit is operated by the Council on Aging through the sponsorship of the Pointe Coupee Police Jury, and is funded by Rural Transit Section 5311, and Pointe Coupee Health Service District.

Pointe Coupee Public Transit provides demand response services to general public, elderly & disabled, and Medicaid clients that reside in Pointe Coupee Parish. The transit system is a demand/response first come first served upon space available. The service is a curb to curb service and transports in Pointe Coupee Parish and Specialty Medical Appointments out of Parish. A minimum 24 hour notice is required on all reservations.

Riders must state all desired stops when booking their reservations.

Escort service is not provided. Disabled people must be able to function on their own or provide their own escort. Escort is allowed to ride free. Pointe Coupee Public Transit is equipped to accommodate disabled persons.

General Public Transportation is provided in Pointe Coupee Parish and Specialty Medical Appointments out of Parish, Monday – Friday. First pick-up 7:00 am, last drop off 5:00 pm. Contracted Transportation is negotiable.

FARE SCHEDULE

General Public Fare(Under the age of 60)

*Within New Roads City limits **\$5.00** round trip **\$1.00** for each additional stop.

*Out of City limit **\$10.00** round trip **\$1.00** for each additional stop.

Senior Citizens Fare (60 years or over)

*Within New Roads City limits **\$2.00** round trip and any additional stops **.25** per stop.

Outside City limits **.50** per stop.

*Out of city limit **\$3.00** round trip, any additional stops **.25** per stop.

*Nutrition Site transportation **.50** round trip any additional stops **.50** per stop.

*Out of city limits Nutrition Site **\$1.00** round trip any additional stops **.50** per stop

*No Senior Citizen will be refused transportation due to inability to pay. If elderly is unable to pay he/she must come to C.O.A. office and apply for a hardship waiver that will be paid with Older American Funds.

Medicaid Transportation

Pointe Coupee Public Transit also provides Medicaid transportation in Pointe Coupee Parish, and Out of parish. If you have Medicaid you **must** call your Medicaid provider to schedule your appointment.

*Within New Roads City limits **\$5.00** round trip **\$1.00** for each additional stop.

*Out of City limit **\$10.00** round trip **\$1.00** for each additional stop.

Senior Citizens Fare (60 years or over)

*Within New Roads City limits **\$2.00** round trip and any additional stops **.25** per stop.

Outside City limits **.50** per stop.

*Out of city limit **\$3.00** round trip, any additional stops **.25** per stop.

*Nutrition Site transportation **.50** round trip any additional stops **.50** per stop.

*Out of city limits Nutrition Site **\$1.00** round trip any additional stops **.50** per stop

*No Senior Citizen will be refused transportation due to inability to pay. If elderly is unable to pay he/she must come to C.O.A. office and apply for a hardship waiver that will be paid with Older American Funds.
